## **Appendix B: Disqualifiers**

- 1. Community Supervision History:
  - (A) has been on court-ordered community supervision or probation for any criminal offense of the grade of Felony.
  - (B) has been on court-ordered community supervision or probation for a criminal offense of the grade of Class A misdemeanor.
  - (C) has been on court-ordered community supervision or probation for a criminal offense of the grade of Class B within the last ten years from the date of the court order.
  - (D) is on court-ordered community supervision or probation for any criminal offense above the grade of class C misdemeanor.
- 2. Is currently charged with any criminal offense for which conviction would be a bar to licensure.
- 3. Conviction History:
  - (A) has been convicted of a felony
  - (B) has been convicted of a class A misdemeanor
  - (C) has been convicted of a Class B misdemeanor or a Class B misdemeanor within the last ten years
  - (D) has a DWI conviction within the last 10 years.
  - (E) Has misdemeanor convictions, including deferred adjudications, above the grade of class C within the last 10 years;
- 4. Has been convicted of any family violence offense of any grade;
- 5. Is prohibited by state or federal law from operating a motor vehicle;
- 6. Is prohibited by state or federal law from possessing firearms or ammunition;
- 7. Has been discharged from any military service under less than honorable conditions including, specifically;
  - (A) under other than honorable conditions;
  - (B) bad conduct;
  - (C) dishonorable;
  - (D) any other characterization of service indicating bad character;
- 8. Has had a commission license denied by final order or revoked;
- 9. Is currently on suspension, or has a voluntary surrender of license currently in effect;
- 10. Has violated any commission rule or provision of the Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 1701;
- 11. Has pending litigation-criminal or civil (including divorce).
- 12. Officers and uniformed police department personnel must conceal any tattoo(s) by use of the authorized uniform or city-authorized clothing.

- 13. Has been convicted of two or more moving violations in the last 12 months.
- 14. Admits to or has been found to have committed an offense under:
  - (A) PC 21.11 Indecency with a Child
  - (B) PC 22.011 Sexual Assault
  - (C) PC 22.021 Aggravated Sexual Assault
